Pre-Surgical Instructions

Please ensure that your pet has nothing to eat or drink after 12 am (midnight)

the night before the day of the procedure.

Please bring your pet into the clinic between the following times on the day of surgery, unless special arrangements have been made in advance.

Surgery drop off time is between 9:00 a.m.-9:30 a.m.

If You Do Not Arrive by 9:30 a.m., you will not be admitted for surgery, and you will forfeit your surgery deposit. Please plan to arrive by 9 a.m. in case of unforeseen issues (weather, traffic, etc.)

During the admission of your pet, we will ask you to sign a consent form. There is also one attached to fill out prior to drop off. Please fill out one form per pet and bring with you the morning of surgery. If your pet is scheduled for a dental, please sign the included dental waiver.

You are reminded that all anesthetic techniques and surgical procedures involve some risk to the Patient. In order to minimize the risks, we will perform a full physical examination on your pet. However, we highly recommend a pre-anesthetic blood testing for all patients, to help screen for many conditions, which may pre-exist but not be physically evident, but which might lead to further complications. The cost of this test, if not already performed, and elected is \$165. If we have not vaccinated your pet(s), then proof of rabies vaccination is required or we will vaccinate your pet today for rabies for a thirty-five dollar fee.

We will contact you with news of your pet's recovery and give you a pick-up time. We will be contacting you from 1-855-738-8227 or 717-344-5484, so please ensure that you supply us with a relevant telephone number for that day.

We will contact you once your pet is out of surgery and in recovery.

At discharge, you will be supplied with a post-operative care sheet for the procedure relevant to your pet's stay with us.

GENERAL QUESTIONS ABOUT THE SURGERY RELEASE FORM

Everything in yellow must be completed.

The rectangle up in the corner that says "In-Clinic Use Only" is for the staff to fill out when you arrive—DO NOT FILL THIS OUT.

IN REGARDS TO THE OPTIONAL SERVICES

What is the preanesthetic lab work? This checks the kidney and liver function to verify they appear to be functioning normally and able to handle the anesthesia. This also checks the red and white blood cells to make sure there isn't any obvious signs of infection or risk of anemia.

What is the E-Collar? This is the Elizabethan Collar, also called the "Cone of Shame". It is a collar in the shape of a cone that helps prevent your pet from licking at their surgery site. This is recommended for all pets. This is also available from most pet stores.

What is the Convenia? This is an antibiotic that is administered by us, while your pet is here today, that lasts for fourteen days. This is recommended for cats, and any pet that is difficult to give pills to orally. As noted, the cost can be excessive if your pet weighs a lot. The cost is thirty-five dollars for the first 13 pounds of body weight and an additional thirty-five dollars for each 13 pounds (or partial pounds) after the first 13 pounds. So, for example, a forty-pound animal would pay one hundred and forty dollars. Thirty-five dollars for pounds 1-13, another thirty-five dollars for pounds 13.1 to 26, another thirty-five dollars for pounds 26.1 to 39, and another thirty-five dollars for pounds 39.1 to 40. So please verify your cost as once we administer it, we cannot take it off your bill.

What about the Biopsy and Radiographs? The biopsy is if your pet is here for the removal of some kind of mass. The biopsy is sent to an outside laboratory for testing to see what sort of tissue and material the mass is composed of. A biopsy can be diagnostic for the suspicion of cancer. Radiographs (X-rays) are used when we are performing a cystotomy (bladder stones).

IN REGARDS TO GENERAL QUESTIONS FOR THE DAY-OF SURGERY

How will we know our pet is ready? Included in the upper left-hand corner of your form is a place for your phone number. This should be a phone number capable of receiving text messages. As soon as your pet is out of surgery and in recovery, we will text you. That text will contain a pickup time for your pet. Until you receive this text message, we do not know when your pet will be ready. If you don't have a phone number capable of receiving text messages, then we will call you.

Can we call you for updates? While our phone number is always available to call, we do not have any information to convey. As soon as your pet is out of surgery and in recovery, we will text you. Until that time, we do not have any updates to share with you. So, you may call, but please don't be upset that we don't have any updates. We are a small practice and we have limits to our staff. However, rest assured all is well. In the incredible chance that anything at all wouldn't be going perfectly, we would contact you right away.

What if we haven't heard from you? If you haven't heard from us, it is mostly likely that your pet isn't out of surgery. There are two major factors that determine pickup time for your pet. First is where they end up on the surgical rotation. The first pet that has surgery will be ready before the last pet that has surgery. The second major factor depends upon the number of surgery appointments we have. The more patients we have the more likely pick-up time will vary. It can be as early as 11 a.m., or as late at 8 p.m. This does not mean we are open until 8 p.m. The vast majority of our surgery days are completed by 4 p.m., but there are exceptions. If you are not available before 4 p.m., please let us know.

What if I still haven't heard from you? You may have not provided a valid phone number, please double check it is clearly written. If we have a valid phone number you will hear from us as soon as your pet is out of surgery and in recovery.
